Dear Participants,

In this document, we will share some useful information with you in connection with our GGS Certification module taking place in Budapest.

Meeting goals

#GoodGovernanceSport Certification module will be held in Budapest, Hungary.

Duration: 3 full working days activities, 2 travel days in the period 28th of November – 02nd of December 2019. The countries involved in the project are the following: Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Poland, Slovakia (3 participants/per country + 2 team members).

Certification training module: During this activity, we will present the analysis to the organizations we have monitored and if needed we will provide participants with consultations about improving their results. Certification module will consist in a 3 days training for management staff of sport organizations at national and local level, that can be different from the ones, that have been analyzed, but the participating experts will be able to reform their organizations, based on the knowledge they will gain and on the recommendation we will launch.

Expected results of the certification module:

1. 21 prepared and trained management staff of sport organizations at national and local level;
2. Increased knowledge and attention on good governance in sport topic and their level of implementation in the organizations they represent;
3. Self-learning path presentation during the event.

Target group:

Employees/volunteers in sport organizations at national and local level.

The profile of the participants:

Each partner organization will participate with 2 participants from the project team and 3 Certification module participants per country, accomplishing the following criteria:

- Employees/volunteers in sport organizations at national and local level;
- Be motivated to develop their competencies in #GoodGovernanceSport;
- Already have experience in working in sport field;
- Be able to act as a multiplier in our local community, ensuring the snowfall effect;

- Able to speak in English, basic level of language knowledge is required in order that the participant feels comfortable during the event.

Weather Forecast

Cold dominates the weather in the month of November in Budapest, Hungary. Freezing weather is likely to be possible, with the chilly current of air that flows over the city this time of year. The average temperature in November is no higher than 5°C, which makes it the fourth coldest month of the whole year, after December, January and February. You may expect some frosty nights when visiting the city in November. Both the average high and low temperature drop significantly in the course of the month. The daytime highs decrease from 11°C to 5°C and the nighttime lows fall from 3°C to -1°C. Needless to say; pack warm clothes and plenty of layers. 😊
